Summary: This report will return the average attendance rate for the selected group of students, for the selected date range. It can be used to find students that fall outside of the acceptable attendance range, with the accumulation of data for CRDC reporting, and to identify the overall attendance rate by District, School, or student selection.




ADA/ADM - by Lunch Status




Daily Attendance Details




Meeting Attendance Summary by Code




School Attendance Summary




Meeting Attendance Summary by Date

Unexcused Absences by Date (Alabama Only)








Contact Tracing - Activities


Contact Tracing - Incidents




Contact Tracing - Transportation




Student Access to Technology




In-District Enrollment Status




School Population Planning






