Meetings Count Toward Coaching Cycles

More Ways to Streamline Workflows

ClassLink and Okta SSO

One less login to manage: Districts using ClassLink or Okta can now authenticate directly from their LaunchPad or SSO portal.

Follow-Up Meeting Prompts

A new Form Settings option lets districts choose whether coaches are prompted to schedule a follow-up meeting right after finishing an observation.

Google Sheets Support

Google Sheets can now be attached to lesson plans and PLU events, alongside the existing support for Google Docs and Slides, giving teams the flexibility to work in whatever file type they already use.

Training Modules

Build and assign training content in Grow as part of PLU Events, complete with quizzes and progress tracking, a natural fit for onboarding new staff this fall.

Network Frequency Dashboard Totals

The Network Frequency Dashboard now includes a district-level totals row, so leaders can spot district-wide trends without piecing the numbers together themselves.

Lesson Plan Link Uploads

Lesson plans now accept a URL as a document option, not just a file upload, so you can link straight to shared drives or outside resources.
